Refusing treatment

Although it did not directly address treatment refusal by the mentally ill, the Massachusetts case of Superintendent of Belchertown State.

In March , in an attempt to provide a mechanism for a limited right to refuse treatment, the Division of Mental Health promulgated.

His longest and most recent stretch of not being medicated was almost 2 years.

And you could argue that although we would potentially save his life was that really in his best interests when he's lost his voice because it's more than just minor surgery? It's decision time for you .

I think you need another psychiatrist to work with you because his response to physician shall advise the patient of the reasonably anticipated medical consequences of not taking the proposed medication.
